**THE MINUTES OF THE
AUGUST 22, 2024 SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSION**

Virtual via Zoom Webinar

Chairperson LEHMANN MORALES was present and called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. (the hour appointed for the meeting was 7:00 p.m.). Commissioner THOMAS-DAVIS, Secretary, was present. In accordance with D.C. Official Code §§ 1–207.42 and 1–309.11(c), the meeting was properly noticed in advance and open to the public.

The Secretary called the roll of members. At that time, it was found that there were:

ABSENT:

A quorum was established.

The Chair called for *Approval of the Agenda*. Commissioner THOMAS-DAVIS moved the agenda for approval, which was seconded. On the question of whether the Commission should approve the agenda, the motion PASSED by unanimous voice vote. The agenda stood APPROVED.

The Chair called up *New Business*.

The only item for consideration was R24-0017, A Resolution Concerning Approval of the Grant Application for a 10th Street Block Party, as sponsored by Commissioner GHORPADEY.

Chair LEHMANN MORALES sought a motion to set limits on debate by Members to 15 minutes, which was moved by Commissioner EASLEY and seconded by Commissioner BHATIA. By a roll call, the motion PASSED. Debate was limited to 15 minutes.

Commissioner GHORPADEY moved the measure for consideration, which was seconded. Chair LEHMANN MORALES sought a motion to extend the limit on debate by Members, which was moved by Commissioner SHERMAN and seconded. By a voice vote, the motion PASSED. Debate was extended by 10 minutes.

The Minutes of the August 22, 2024 Special Meeting of the Commission

Chair LEHMANN MORALES sought a motion to extend the limit on debate by Members, which was moved by Commissioner EASLEY and seconded. By a voice vote, the motion PASSED. Debate was extended by 5 minutes.

Following extensive debate and comments from Members of the Commission and from the public, an amendment was offered by Commissioner EASLEY.

EASLEY Amendment #1: To strike at line 35, the phrase "\$2,240.00" and insert "\$500.00" in its place. The amendment was accepted as friendly and APPROVED.

With all debate time exhausted, the Chair called the question, for passage of R24-0017, A Resolution Concerning Approval of the Grant Application for a 10th Street Block Party, which by voice vote, was APPROVED unanimously.

With no further business before the Commission, the Chair called the meeting to a close, noting that the next regular meeting of ANC 1A is Wednesday, September 11, 2024. The Chair adjourned the meeting at 8:30 p.m.
