Re: FY2025 Q1 1A Allotment

The Office of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) received ANC 1A's 3rd quarter FY 2024 financial report and the minutes approving the report. The OANC still needs to receive the canceled checks and all invoices or receipts for checks 1590 through 1597. The report and all supporting documentation are required by D.C. Official Code, Section 1-309.13 (j) (1).

Therefore, the OANC recommends withholding ANC 1A's 1^{st} quarter FY 2025 allotment for \$6,806.45 to satisfy the above code violations.

The code requires that: The treasurer of a Commission shall prepare a quarterly financial report on a form provided by the OANC. The financial report shall be presented to the Commission for its consideration at a Commission meeting within 45 days after the end of the quarter. A copy of the approved financial report, signed by the Chairperson, the secretary, and the treasurer, shall be filed, along with a record of the vote adopting the report, with the OANC within 15 days of approval. Each quarterly report shall include copies of canceled checks, bank statements, grant request letters and grant disbursements, invoices and receipts, executed contracts, details about all contributions received during the time period covered by the quarterly report, the minutes of all meetings indicating the Commission's approval of disbursements during the time period covered by the quarterly report, and certification of the Commission's approval of the quarterly report signed by the Commission's Secretary.

The ANC may cure this violation by submitting the canceled checks and receipts or invoices for checks 1590 through 1597 before December 15, 2024.
