  1900 block of 7th St Curb Cut Closure specifically, the resolution requests
  that the entire block to be closed off with no curb cuts; to deal with current
  illegal activities and parking on that block.
  - O MOTION: Commissioner Trindade Deramo moved that the full ANC 1B approves the 1900 block of 7th street NW curb street cut closure resolution as printed and distributed also noting that the second "Be Resolved" clause in this resolution requests that DDOT employ curb concrete curb stops for the entirety of the buffer to prevent drivers from running over flex posts to illegally park. The Commissioner moved that this resolution be adopted. The motion was seconded. The motion PASSED (8 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstention).
- Commissioner Chauvin introduced an amendment to two existing settlement agreements with Whitlows at 901 U St NW.
