Per D.C. Code, Section 1-309.13, the Office of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) initiated a review of the 2nd quarter FY23 financial report for ANC 1C.

DC Code 1-309.13 (j)(1) requires that each quarterly report shall include copies of canceled checks, bank statements, grant request letters and grant disbursements, invoices, and receipts, executed contracts, details about all contributions received during the period covered by the quarterly report.	

By withholding this allotment, the ANC has \$12,236.97 remaining from the annual allotment of \$23,108.06.
