Re: Q3 FY24 1C Allotment

The Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) has not received 1C's 1st quarter FY 2024 financial report or the receipts/invoices for checks 4049 - 4061. The report and supporting documentation are required by D.C. Code, Section 1-309.13 (j) (1). It was due February 15, 2024.

## Therefore, the OANC recommends withholding ANC 1C's 3rd quarter FY 2024 allotment of \$5,830.74 for violating the above-referenced code.

The code requires that: The treasurer of a Commission shall prepare a quarterly financial report on a form provided by the OANC. The financial report shall be presented to the Commission for its consideration at a Commission meeting within 45 days after the end of the quarter. A copy of the approved financial report, signed by the Chairperson, the secretary, and the treasurer, shall be filed, along with a record of the vote adopting the report, with the OANC within 15 days of approval. Each quarterly report shall include copies of canceled checks, bank statements, grant request letters and grant disbursements, invoices and receipts, executed contracts, details about all contributions received during the time period covered by the quarterly report, the minutes of all meetings indicating the Commission's approval of disbursements during the time period covered by the Commission's approval of the quarterly report signed by the Commission's secretary.

## The ANC may cure this violation by submitting the required documents before July 31, 2024.

Since the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarterly FY 2024 allotment will not be released to ANC 1C, \$15,684.43 remains available for release in quarterly amounts following the OANC's receipt, review, and approval of the related financial reports.
