 - a. Our ANC received our FYQ1 allotment of roughly \$5,100

- 7. City Official Comments (Pirrotti)
 - a. Ward 4 CM Lewis George's office Barbara Rogers joined to provide various updates to our community
 - The Clear Lanes camera bus enforcement program is in effect for bus stops, and will soon be in effect for bus lanes
 - Applications for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) closed after the District received 3,500 applications in less than 10 days. Applications will reopen again on January 1, April 1, and July 1 and accept 3,500 more applications per quarter. If you require support with your ERAP application, please email erap.program@dc.gov or reach out to the CM's team.
 - CM Lewis George is asking agencies to work to minimize disruptions from construction associated with the DC PLUG program
 - The CM noted the ongoing debates over additional legislation to address crime and violence in the city, and invited residents to sign up for the CM's newsletter by text at (202) 286-5268.
