Community Reports

Council	Oliver Stout III, CM Parker's office		
	The office is creating an Advisory Committee whose work will exclusively focus on DC's Senior (60+) residents in Ward 5. Interested residents are invited to consider serving on this 9 member Committee for 2 years. Meetings will be held bi-monthly.		

There were two fatalities in Ward 5 and the office was engaged with MPD to gather more information and strategize on mitigation. Invited the residents to join the CM's Performance Oversight meetings. The Mayor is expected to release the budget on March 22, 2023. Residents were given time to ask questions/comment directly. The following topics were raised: 1. 8th Street one-way 2. What to do about vehicle parked on (and blocking) sidewalk 3. Pylons on 18th & Monroe 4. DPW services – bin delivery MOCR none MPD Lt. Devlin: In the past 30 day period – the stats "moved in the good direction" – 2 robberies in 5B, 1 of those were closed; 11 auto theft; petty theft around 12th and Newton. Capt. Ryan Small: 5% increase from previous 30 days but 36% down from same period last year. No updates were available about the bodies found in the backyard of a house on Kearny. Coffee/ice cream with the cop – next event in 5D

Special Presentation - TSI 2.0/DDOT

Mr. Dalando Baker presented about the new TSI 2.0 and how DDOT is prioritizing locations for these investigations. The following topics were part of the discussion:

- 1. What is the role of the ANC in the new TSI 2.0 process
 - a. None
- What data does DDOT look at while determining the outcomes of TSI applications
 - a. MPD Reports only [*Note: Police reports are not filed if there are no injuries or significant property damage.]
 - b. Anecdotal reports or near-misses are not considered.
- 3. Safe Routes traffic locations are prioritized through a different process and is not part of TSI 2.0.
- 4. The Mayor's Transportation Oversight meeting is scheduled for February 27, 2023, at 9:30am.
