## **Public Forum**

Floor was held to hear a number of comments from the public. Majority of the conversations were around the BZA case for 3315 12<sup>th</sup> Street NE. Several neighbors voiced their opposition for the current plans for this site. Reasons were:

- a. Sun shade for neighboring property
- b. Noise from HVAC units
- c. Relocation of HVAC units
- d. Bike parking
- e. Feasibility of restricting parking for residents
- f. Enforcement of restricted parking
- g. Over- saturation going from 1 family to 12
- h. Sub-terrain units will/may negatively impact health of residents
