 ANC 5D voted 7-1-1 in support of the project (abstention: Cobb; opposed: Rhodes), with the expectation that JGB and Gallaudet will consider feedback provided by ANC 5D as they finalize the design elements of their project (motion: Sauceda-Guzman; second: Blacknell)
- Z.C. Case No. 22-21: PUD; 2225-2229 M St. NE 2229 M Street, LLC 9:00 PM
 ANC 5D voted 8-0-1 (abstention: Cobb) to table voting action for Z.C. Case No. 22-21 until the

February 2023 public meeting (motion: Blacknell; second: Roblin).

- ANC 5D shared concerns with 2229 M Street, LLC regarding the lack of built-in parking options, the overall size of the PUD and a large and historic tree at the rear of the property. 2229 M Street, LLC promised to share a tree study and provide renderings to the Commission as follow-up.

 ANC 5D voted 9-0-0 to approve the letter (motion: Sauceda-Guzman; second: McCullum) with a discussed amendment to ensure that an environmental impact assessment be conducted and that
