Re: FY2024 Q4 8F Allotment

The Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) reviewed 8F's 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2024 financial report, the minutes approving the report, and most of the supporting documents. The ANC still needs to provide invoices/receipts for checks 113 and 115 and the debit card (DB) transactions 22 and 30. The report and supporting documentation are required by D.C. Official Code, Section 1-309.13 (j) (1).

We also found that 8F was not approved for the FY 2024 Security Fund. The DC Official Code 1-309.13 (c), prior to July 8, 2024, stated that: *No expenditure shall be made by a Commission during a vacancy in the office of treasurer or at any time when a current and accurate statement and bond or its equivalent are not on file with the Auditor*. The ANC disbursed \$4,709.77 during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. This amount must be disallowed and cannot be cured.

Therefore, based on the above code violations, we must withhold the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter allotment of \$3,659.82. An additional \$1,049.95 will be withheld from the FY25 Q1 allotment.

ANC 8F received \$10,979.58 from their FY 2024 annual allotment of \$14,639.40.
