The Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) received 6B's 3rd quarter FY 2024 financial report, bank statements, and canceled checks. However, the OANC still needs to receive the invoice or receipt for check 4901 and minutes showing the approval of the 3rd quarter FY 2024 financial report. The report and all supporting documents are required by the D.C. Official Code, Section 1-309.13 (j) (1).

Therefore, the OANC recommends withholding ANC 6B's 1st quarter FY 2025 allotment for \$6,055.16 for violating the above-referenced code.

The code requires that: The treasurer of a Commission shall prepare a quarterly financial report on a form provided by the OANC. The financial report shall be presented to the Commission for its consideration at a Commission meeting within 45 days after the end of the quarter. A copy of the approved financial report, signed by the Chairperson, the secretary, and the treasurer, shall be filed, along with a record of the vote adopting the report, with the OANC within 15 days of approval. Each quarterly report shall include copies of canceled checks, bank statements, grant request letters and grant disbursements, invoices and receipts, executed contracts, details about all contributions received during the time period covered by the quarterly report, the minutes of all meetings indicating the Commission's approval of disbursements during the time period covered by the quarterly report, and certification of the Commission's approval of the quarterly report signed by the Commission's Secretary.

The ANC may cure this violation by submitting the required documents before December 15, 2024.
