- Letter of Support for Juneteenth Celebration 2025 – Removed from agenda due to measures discussed during previous community forum.

PRESENTERS:

DPW {10mins}:

- **Warnique West, Administrator – DC Department of Public Works**

presented/responded to questions:

Commissioners:

- Comm'r Humphrey noted that the 3000 Alabama Ave (alleyway to be cleaned), inquired as to collaborations with park services regarding trash removal. Ms. West noted that street cleaning/leaf collections are the same team and scheduling is rotated. 10/28/2024 begins leaf collections. Steven Thompson admin for noted he'd also was available to support collaborations with appropriate.
- Comm'r Swanson noted a property 1600 20th PI SE with rodent infestation, limited trash pick-up, ect. Ms. West asked Mr. Thompson to send an inspector for assessment and informed him that possible fines could be imposed. Comm'r also noted that the Old Pope funeral home {2617 Penn Ave SE} Developer of new project aren't adhering to proper trash disposal and asked that an inspection be done at site as well. Comm'r also inquired about street receptacle to address litter/trash on streets for which Ms. West noted abuse of use {residential trash dumping} now they only place receptacles at the nearest business site – Dream City 2800 12th Street SE.
- Comm'r Robinson noted that form Erie St to Alabama Ave SE illegal dumping/loose liter requires attention \ 2900 blk. Ms. West asked Mr. Thompson to address the matter. Comm'r Robinson to provided location details.

- Comm’r Adams noted his understanding as to improper use of community receptacles as he highlighted resident/household trash dumping at the receptacle at the 3100 blk/Mass Ave.SE. Ms. West noted how personal residential trash could be identified and fines levied as well.
- Chairman Brown noted concerns as to why Ward 7 appears to be placed at the end of scheduling calendar for leaf collection. Ms. West noted that there is no preference for scheduling throughout Wards. Collections are disseminated equally throughout the city. Ms. West also noted her oversight responsibilities for snow removal and provided details for pending schedule modifications.

Residents:

- Kendrick West 3117 Alabama Ave SE noted multiple cleaning requests and asked that the street draining grad in alley be cleared for proper water flow. Ms. West asked for services number request(s) and noted she’d have a team assess.
- Linda Fletcher inquired about yard waste pick-up. She was advised to place it in her trash/near trash. Eddie noted that yard waste is all year around and encouraged that a 311-collection request be scheduled.
- Ashley Emerson inquired as to scheduling for street cleaning {Hillcrest Rec Ctr/ Library}. Ms. West noted that from Feb-March each street is cleaned twice and noted that she’d provide a map/scheduling. Would be willing to provide accommodation if needed.

➤ **Director of Constituent Serv. D.L. Humphrey:**
