

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 7D

April 2024 Meeting Minutes

6:32 Chair Felder calls the meeting to order. Commissioners Davis, Payne, Astmann, Alcorn, Schapitl and Eby are present. The April agenda is adopted unanimously.

6:35: Shaun Moore from DC Water provides an update on the Lead Free DC Program. The initiative is working to verify and replace 42,000 lead and galvanized iron water service lines across the District. Under this initiative, service line replacement (from the water main in the street to the home) will be completed for free. 5,000 lead service lines have been replaced.

7:15: Dellannea Hutchinson from the DC Department of Buildings presents on how the agency manages investigations of potentially vacant properties and holds property owners accountable for vacancies and costs associated with clean up.

7:40: Lawrence Davin from the Mayor's Office of Community Relations provides an update on the new deal to keep the Caps and Wizards in D.C., the Mayor's proposed Budget, opening of the Real Time Crime Center Opening and Camera Connect Program, as well as the DPW Public Meeting

7:53: Francis Campbell from Councilmember Vince Gray's office provides an update on Kia upgrades. and steering wheel locks.

7:55: Captain Monahan and Captain Augustine from MPD provide an update on efforts to combat violent crime and some progress In reducing property and other crime.

8:18: Commissioner Astmann provides the Treasurer's Report and FY 2024 Q2 Quarterly Financial Report. He moves an amendment to adjust the balance given an OANC software issue, which is supported unanimously. CMSR Astmann had previously submitted the QFR having used an OANC generated report with slightly different calculations than the actual numbers. The new generated report fixed that minor error. The report is agreed to unanimously.

8:22: Commissioner Astmann nominates Heather Bonome to the Public Safety Committee, which is unanimously agreed to.

8:23: Committees provide updates. Chair Barnett shares information about public safety resources. Chair Abramovitz recaps a presentation from Empower DC, Department of Buildings, and Hill East Parcel B on Reservation 13 for a BZA case. Commissioner Eby recaps presentations on the Potomac Avenue and 19th Street redesign project and the pre-and post-studies to see impacts.

9:07: The Commission considers committee business. The commission discusses a letter to DDOT in support of NOI 24-72-TESD, roadway improvements at the intersection of 16th/North Carolina/C Streets NE. Commissioner Astmann highlights suggestion to add additional signage. The letter is supported unanimously. The committee also supports exploring hiring of administrative support part-time.

9:18: Commissioners provide SMD reports.
