6:35: Commissioner Felder calls meeting to order

6:40: Commission adopts February agenda and March meeting minutes by voice.

6:45: DDOT Director Everett Lott presents overview of DDOT priority projects on traffic calming, bicycle lanes, and bus service. Director Lott's presentation is followed by commissioner and community questions.

7:20: D.C. city and government officials provide presentations. (MPD, MOCRE, and Councilmember Gray)

7:38: Commissioners provide SMD presentations.

7:45: Commission votes unanimously to support depository bank, quarterly financial statements and draft budget. Commission stipulates budget may be adjusted as commission develops further and priorities are added.

7:55-8:02: Commission begins discussion of forming committees to include Housing/Economic Development/Economic Justice; Transportation/Public Space; Grants/Community Safety; Grants/Community Outreach; Environment; and Public Safety. Commission votes unanimously to form committees, with Commissioner Friend noting that the names of committees are subject to change.

8:02-8:08: Commission discusses potential bylaws changes with Commissioner Friend noting that community will have time to review amendment and provide comments.

8:08-8:15: State Board of Education Member for Ward 7 Eboni-Rose Thompson presents her resolution on expansion of the Safe Passage program as well as her efforts to highlight Ward 7 students during Black History Month. Commission votes unanimously to support the Safe Passage Resolution.

8:15-8:28: DDOT Sean Burnett, Supervisory Management and Transportation Planner, and Will Handsfield, Bicycle Program Specialist, present department proposal on 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Potomac Avenue Traffic Calming and Bicycle Lane project. Commission votes unanimously to support the project, with the stipulation that there will be minimal disruption to street parking.
