Minutes of the Meeting of June 2024

Please note: In compliance with Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised, 11th Edition, 48, page 468, the minutes of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 7D are a record of actions taken by the Commission, not a record of what people said during the meeting. Accordingly, comments made by Commissioners or members of the public are not recorded in detail in the minutes.

- The Commission convened at approximately 6:32. Chair Felder, Commissioner Hasan, Commissioner Davis, Commissioner Payne, Commissioner Astmann, Commissioner Friend, Vice Chair Alcorn, Commissioner Schapitl, and Commissioner Eby-Stockert are present. The meeting agenda and meeting minutes for March, April, and May are unanimously adopted with one amendment to reflect Commissioner Payne's presence at the May meeting.
- Clint Osborn from D.C. Homeland Security and Emergency Management presents on the agency's work to coordinate emergency response for events like Inauguration and help manage crises like the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Michelle Wilson from the D.C. Department of Corrections presents on plans for the new treatment facility annex project, including budgetary challenges and programming to ensure returning citizens do not reoffend.
- Ayanna Williams from D.C. Natives presents on their pollinator program and explains how residents can pursue new gardens working with their volunteers.
- Lawrence Davin from the Mayor's Office of Community Relations and Francis Campbell from Councilmember Vince Gray's office shared updates on youth summer programs, including summer meals.
- Representatives from MPD shared updates on efforts to combat violent crime in Hill East, including efforts to deal with nuisance properties.
- The Commissioner unanimously adopts the Treasurer's report.
- The Commission unanimously supports motions from Economic Development Committee to advance efforts on blighted properties and a BZA letter.
- The Commission votes to send a letter to DDOT concerning NOI-24-127-NESD sharing feedback on that agency's plans for 17th Street NE bicycle facility. Commissioners Hasan, Payne, Astmann, Friend, Alcorn, Davis and Eby vote AYE.
