Re: RESTORE Q1 FY23 8D Allotment

In accordance with D.C. Code, Section 1-309.13, the Office of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) recommended the forfeiture of ANC 8D's 1st quarter FY23 allotment of \$5,664.81 because the ANC did not provide minutes approving the 3Q22 QFR.

Subsequently, the ANC provided the May 2023 minutes, approving the 3Q22 QFR. Therefore, the OANC recommends restoring \$5,405.83. This is the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2023 allotment of \$5,664.81, less \$258.98 for the undocumented expense related to check 2492.
