Re: RESTORE Q3 FY23 8D Allotment

In accordance with D.C. Code, Section 1-309.13, the Office of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) recommended the forfeiture of ANC 8D's 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY23 allotment of \$5,224.04 because the ANC did not provide the minutes approving the 1Q23 QFR.

Subsequently, the ANC provided the May 2023 minutes, approving the 1Q23 QFR. Therefore, the **OANC** recommends restoring \$4,933.90. This is the 3rd quarter 2023 allotment of \$5,224.04, less \$290.14, for exceeding the nominal refreshment limit of \$100.00.
