Assault, 4 as compared to 3 Robbery 6 as compared to 2 Overall crime is down 22% Property Crime 7 as compared to 0 Motor vehicle theft 18 as compared to 4 (Hyundai & Kia) Theft auto 4 as compared to 4 Total crime is up 38% as compared to last year. Commissioner Moody asks about what is being done. Answer: Results are in changing the tours of hours for police for when these motor vehicle thefts happen (middle of the night/early morning).
