2023 Report.

Thank you so much for a wonderful year. Over the past months, we are proud of some key accomplishments on behalf of the 2F community:

- In October, ANC 2F <u>requested</u> that DDOT prioritize implementation of Automated Traffic Enforcement (ATE) along 15th Street NW from Massachusetts Avenue NW to U Street NW; reduce the speed limit and re-time traffic signals; improve signage; consider raised crosswalks, all-way stop signs; prioritize restoration of all bike lane safety markings at alleys and intersections; study reducing the roadway to two (2) thru travel lanes; and process all TSIs for the unsignalized intersections in the corridor at once.
- In September, ANC 2F <u>asked DDOT</u> undertake the following efforts: 1) Renewed focus on completing negotiations with Virginia and Maryland on reciprocity of automated tickets; 2) Increase funding and staffing for the Department of Public Works to increase the number of vehicles with high numbers of outstanding tickets which are booted, 3) Initiate strategies that prioritize enforcement for expired and fake tags with booting and impoundment.
- In March, ANC 2F supported Jane Jane's application for an enclosed sidewalk café.
- Throughout the year, ANC 2F continued to work with neighbors and representatives of Aslin Beer Company to resolve concerns around noise and trash mitigation, including participation in a fact-finding committee with ABCA.
- Throughout the year, ANC 2F entered into Settlement Agreements with Trade, the Muni, Amelie Wine Bar, Dog Daze, Vegas Lounge, and the Little Gay Pub.
- In December, ANC 2F will vote on a template <u>Settlement Agreement</u> for licensed cannabis retail establishments.
