

## ANC 6C Annual Report 2024

ANC 6C, to meet the requirements of Section 1.309-10(n-1) of the Code of the District of Columbia, reports that during the twelve months since the 2023 Annual Report, conducted the following:

Held 11 public meetings of the commission, via WebEx platform;

At these meetings provided opportunity for brief community announcements from members of the public, government officials, and representatives of various organizations;

- Benefited from the work of commissioners and 6C residents appointed to the following committees: Alcoholic Beverage Licensing; Grants; Planning, Zoning, and Economic Development; Transportation and Public Space;
- Protested six applications for alcoholic and beverage or medical cannabis licenses or renewals if settlement agreements were not reached beforehand;
- Approved recommendations on matters of concern to the Mayor and the Council of the District of Columbia, and to agencies and departments of the District of Columbia; including on crime, on transportation safety, and on the commercialization of residential property to the Mayor and Council of the District of Columbia; at least five to the District Department of Transportation; and at least four to other District offices;
- Designated commissioners or committee members to represent ANC 6C in seven hearings, meetings or proceedings, including six related to alcoholic beverage or cannabis licensing matters;
- Although the Environment and Parks Committee dissolved at the January meeting, ANC 6C continued to regularly monitor the development of parks and open spaces, as well as the condition and maintenance of parks throughout the ANC 6C area, particularly Stanton Park; and
- Posted agendas, minutes and reports of its meetings and committee meetings, and copies of its correspondence, as well as information on items of interest, on a timely basis, on its website.
