Minutes approved at 2/12/2025 meeting.

1) CALL TO ORDER

- a) The meeting was called to order at 6:45pm by Commissioner Warburton (4C03)
- b) Commissioner Warburton (4C03) was unanimously approved as Chair Pro-Tempore.
- c) Also present were Commissioner Winternitz (4C01), Commissioner Kirby (4C02), Commissioner Kovacevic (4C04), Commissioner Kademian (4C05), Commissioner Boas Hayes (4C06), and Commissioner Heller (4C07).
- d) This meeting was held in person at the Petworth Library and virtually via Zoom.

5) NEW BUSINESS

- a) ANC 4C Officer Nominations and Election
 - i) Commissioner Warburton was nominated for Chair. Commissioner Warburton was elected Chair. (7-0-0)
 - ii) Commissioner Boas Hayes was nominated for Vice Chair. Commissioner Boas Hayes was elected Vice Chair. (7-0-0)
 - iii) Commissioner Kovacevic was nominated for Secretary. Commissioner Kovacevic was elected as Secretary. (7-0-0)
 - iv) Commissioner Kirby was nominated for Treasurer. Commissioner Kirby declined the nomination. No other commissioner was nominated for Treasurer.

- c) ANC Security Fund Opt-In
 - i) There was a motion to defer the approval of the Security Fund opt in. No objection - the motion to defer the ANC Security Fun Opt-In until a later meeting was unanimously approved.
- d) Finalize ANC 4C Calendar Year 2025 Meeting Schedule
 - i) Commissioner Warburton provided an overview of the 2025 ANC 4C meeting schedule, meeting on the second Wednesday of every month with a recess in August.
 - ii) Commissioner Kirby proposed an additional month of recess. After discussion amongst the commissioners, December was added as a month of recess in the 2025 meeting schedule.

 - (1) There was a motion to approve the updated 2025 schedule. The updated 2025 meeting schedule was unanimously approved.

 - (1) Areas of focus for 2025 include Kansas/8th/Allision intersection. Public comment asked for the 1300/1400 block of Taylor to be included.

- 8) **COMMUNITY FORUM**
 - a) Neighbors residing on the 4100 block of 13th Street NW raised concerns about increased traffic and parking demand that could come from a map amendment application that rezones the western half the 1200 block of Taylor and Upsher Streets, NW from PDR-1 (Production, Distribution and Repair Zone) to MU-4 (Mixed-Use Zone).
 - b) Concern was raised that properties are being marked vacant without cause.
