Re: FY 2025 Q2 8A Allotment – Partial Release

The Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) received 8A's 4th quarter FY 2024 financial report, along with most of the required documents. **However, the ANC has not provided the invoice or receipt for check 1088, Ever Bank, N.A., for \$498.92**. The D.C. Official Code requires the report and all supporting documents, as specified in Section 1-309.13(j)(1).

Therefore, the OANC recommends releasing \$4,244.22 of ANC 8A's allotment of \$4,743.14 for the 2nd quarter of FY 2025 and withholding \$498.92 for violating the above-referenced code.

The code requires that: The treasurer of a Commission shall prepare a quarterly financial report on a form provided by the OANC. The financial report shall be presented to the Commission for its consideration at a Commission meeting within 45 days after the end of the quarter. A copy of the approved financial report, signed by the Chairperson, the secretary, and the treasurer, shall be filed, along with a record of the vote adopting the report, with the OANC within 15 days of approval. Each quarterly report shall include copies of canceled checks, bank statements, grant request letters and grant disbursements, invoices and receipts, executed contracts, details about all contributions received during the time period covered by the quarterly report, the minutes of all meetings indicating the Commission's approval of disbursements during the time period covered by the Commission is secretary.

The ANC may cure this violation by submitting the required documents before May 15, 2025.
