VII. Reports & Presentations

A. Yu Ying Update (5A05) Jose Soussa

They provided an update on their construction. Holds elementary grades 1-5.
Working with neighbors on parking options. Continue to work with neighbors on
pick up and drop off. Discussed pick up and drop off procedures for single
campus and dual campus families. Working on getting crossing guards and
looking to add a stop sign. Also looking to install crosswalks. Met with the
community in January. Planning another meeting in March. ANC 5A willing to
work on Safe Routes to school with the school. Discussed measures taking to
address traffic and parking.

B. Washington Latin Update Cooper Campus (5A05) Peter Anderson

Construction well underway. Expect to move into the campus in the summer of 2025/ Renovating the Kirov building and then building the new building behind that. There will be a fence and a gate that is closed during the day. It will be open during pick up and drop off on the loop that goes through the campus. They will have a full middle school (5th-8th) and 9th grade the first year. There is a rooftop terrace with a basketball court. They have been meeting with neighbors to talk about their plans about traffic. Most students coming by Metro Train, Metro bus and their own chartered bus. There will be some parents drop off. Faculty are encouraged to use alternative ways to get to work. There is very limited staff parking. Wanting to be a resource for the community- meetings and events. 450 students this fall. Will add a grade each year. In three years will be a little over 700 students at full capacity. There will be a community meeting on March 6th to discuss the request to conduct construction on holidays. The Edgewood temporary campus is the one moving to this new campus. Copper campus has a majority of students from Ward %. But, they come from all over the city. There was a discussion about ways to try to make efforts to get more kids from the neighborhood at these schools.

C. 1 Hawaii Ave Update (5A06) Joe Nelson

A full renovation project. 4 Story, 70 Unit building. Targeting Lead Platinum. Highest rating for a affordable housing development. Construction continues on the outside through Mid-May. Interior work will start next January. Move in will start in February 2026. They have used 23 weather days. Requesting April and May holiday work days. 42% complete construction at this point.

D. McDonald's Update (5A08)

Final permit received from department of buildings. Building will close on Saturday, March 1st and last day of business will be on Friday. Goal to reopen in August around Labor Day weekend. Demolition will start in April. They shared a traffic control plan during construction. The seating plan has also been modified from what was originally presented to the community. They will be updating the main area to be consistent with other new Mc Donald's. They are adding self service kiosks. Current seating is 72 and going to 22. Can do a seating study to confirm how many seats were used. They will look at ways to add more seating. Encouraged to create a website with up to date information. Information was provided about the construction related to the car and pedestrian traffic. Will post a QR code and a contact number on site. Mc Donalds will be back to present at a special meeting on Thursday, March 13th with complete plan to address all of the concerns that were raised tonight including a communications plan.
