- MPD has been busy assisting with President Carter's funeral and the upcoming Inauguration
- Ended 2024 with 12% decrease in violent crime and 12% decrease in property crime
- 24% decrease so far in 2025
- Officers will focus on robbery prevention ie highly expensive coats
- There were two homicides reported in ANC 7F
- There are press releases involving crimes in our area
- Commissioner Green inquired about the incident where the streets were closed off around 6D on Sunday, January 5, 2024, it was handled, the person had fireworks, the suspect was arrested (warrant)
- MPD Citizens Meetings on 3rd Wednesday of every month at 6 pm
- Constituent Concerns:
 - Queen Mother and Mr. Blue about reporting incidents in the neighborhood such as gun shots going off and lack of police presence after (Queen Mother), also an officer spoke about an officer telling people that someone is snitching on them (Blue) Officer Medina stated that they do not tolerate that type of behavior and when reported it will be handled appropriately, officers are not sent to a scene just because of the sounds of gunshots but many times they are patrolling but you may not hear the gunshots
 - Concerns about people loitering outside of stores Officer Medina stated that there is NOT a No Loitering law in Washington, DC
 - Citizen spoke about noise ordinance times and is this the case across the city
