8D01	DHCD requested comment on their proposal to provide approximately \$23,602,679 in Housing Production Trust Funds financing to Flats at South Capitol located at 3836-3840 South Capitol Street SE and 3848 South Capitol Street SE. Commissioner Brown wrote a letter in opposition and submitted it for the record. The basis for her position was the saturation of her SMD, and the neighborhood overall, with low income housing without balancing it with retail, amenities or upmarket housing. Notice of an application for a raze permit has been posted at the cityowned property at 199 Chesapeake Street SW. No information is available about the plans for it.

8D07	Case No. 21229 to construct a new 11-unit apartment building on the blighted lots at 62-64 Forrester Street SW was heard by the Board of Zoning Adjustments (BZA) on February 26. Two options were two semi-detached houses or the apartment building. Only the latter provided economies of scale to offset the site preparation costs. Commissioner Brown presented on behalf of ANC 8D and submitted her testimony for the record. Although the Commission did not take an official position, she spoke favorably of the proposed construction on vacant land, in consultation with the Commissioner-elect and residents of SMD 8D07. The request was approved and case closed.	
	Ongoing issues remain about the demolition and redevelopment of Martin's View apartment complex. The tenant's association is planning to leverage TOPA during the transition period.
