Traveling Internationally and Want To Access Your Email?

For Commissioners planning to travel internationally, you will need to obtain an "authenticator" to access your ANC email. To gain access to the authenticator, you must provide the following information **BEFORE** you leave the country.

Once you obtain the software, you will not need to request it again for future travel unless you plan to upload it to a different device.
