**Re:** FY 2025 Q4 8E Allotment – Provisional Release

---

Pursuant to Section 1-309.13 (j) (1) of the D.C. Official Code, the Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) received and reviewed ANC 8E's 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2025 financial report, bank statements, canceled checks, signed minutes and supporting documents. The report and supporting documentation met the requirements of D.C. Official Code, Section 1-309.13(j)(1).

**Based on our review, the OANC recommends releasing ANC 8E's allotment of \$5,986.79 for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of FY 2025.**

**Beginning in FY 2026 (October 1, 2025),** no allotments will be released to ANC 8E until ANC 8E has complied with the D.C. Official Code requirement to file a response to the Auditor for each infraction in the Auditor's report. Per the D.C. Official Code 1-309.13(d)(3), the mandatory penalty is being delayed until the next fiscal year because D.C. Official Code 1-309.13(d)(3) states that allotments "shall be forfeited until the response has been filed." When a penalty is imposed this close to the end of a fiscal year, the ANC may not be able to recover forfeited monies upon compliance. This also constitutes the final warning to ANC 8E.
