Vote on Requests for Grants from ANC 3A to support Friends of Hearst Park project to preserve the health of heritage trees around Hearst Field

The heritage oaks that line the lower field and the walkway at Hearst Park have been suffering from drainage issues and other challenges. At the ANC 3A October public meeting, 501(c)3 organization Friends of Hearst Park presented a request for a grant of \$5,000 to support “vertical mulching” (aerating and replenishing the soil around the base of the trees) to maximize their chances to survive. The work would occur in late 2025. DC law allows ANC's to give grants to public purpose organizations to pay costs for a proposed project that would benefit the community, focusing on people who live and work in the Commission area. The ANC invites public comments on the proposed grant by email to 3A@anc.dc.gov or to individual Commissioners.

Discussion on proposed zoning text amendment ZC 25-13 to implement the Wisconsin Avenue Development Guidelines covering the corridor from Friendship Heights to Rodman Street NW

The development guidelines were formulated by the DC Office of Planning (OP) in 2023-2024 after speaking to the affected ANC's and seeking public comments. OP presented its proposed zoning changes at the October ANC 3A meeting, and has also developed draft zoning language to carry forward the guidelines, which will be considered by the Zoning Commission at a virtual hearing on December 11. The Zoning Commission is seeking comments and plans to hold two votes on the proposed language after the hearing, with time for public comment before the hearing and at least 30 days for public comment between the first and second vote. The ANC invites public comments and may consider a vote on a position to submit to the Zoning Commission.

Presentation by Joseph Ogundeyi on ATME free mobile/web platform designed to enhance drivers' communication and convenience by allowing them to share updates with others using the app

This presentation was postponed from the October meeting. ATME www.atmeapps.com would facilitate sharing information about break-ins, thefts or other incidents anonymously using license plate numbers. The app is intended to promote community engagement and neighborhood safety, encourage better driving practices, and facilitate communication among neighbors about concerns related to transportation, parking and other shared interests.

- District Hypothermia Shelters during Cold Alerts

This winter season the District has organized hypothermia shelters to serve people who are unhoused when the temperature is expected to be 32° F., or 40°F or below with a 50% or greater chance of precipitation. Please call the Shelter Hotline 202-399-7093 or 311 to report unhoused individuals so the outreach team can arrange transportation for them to get to a shelter. The nearest men's shelter is at 1725 Lincoln Road NE in Ward 5 (130 beds, 24 hours). The nearest women's shelters are at 6010 Georgia Avenue in Ward 4 (30 beds, 7 pm-7 am) and at N Street Village, 810 5th Street NW in Ward 2 (134 beds, 24 hours). 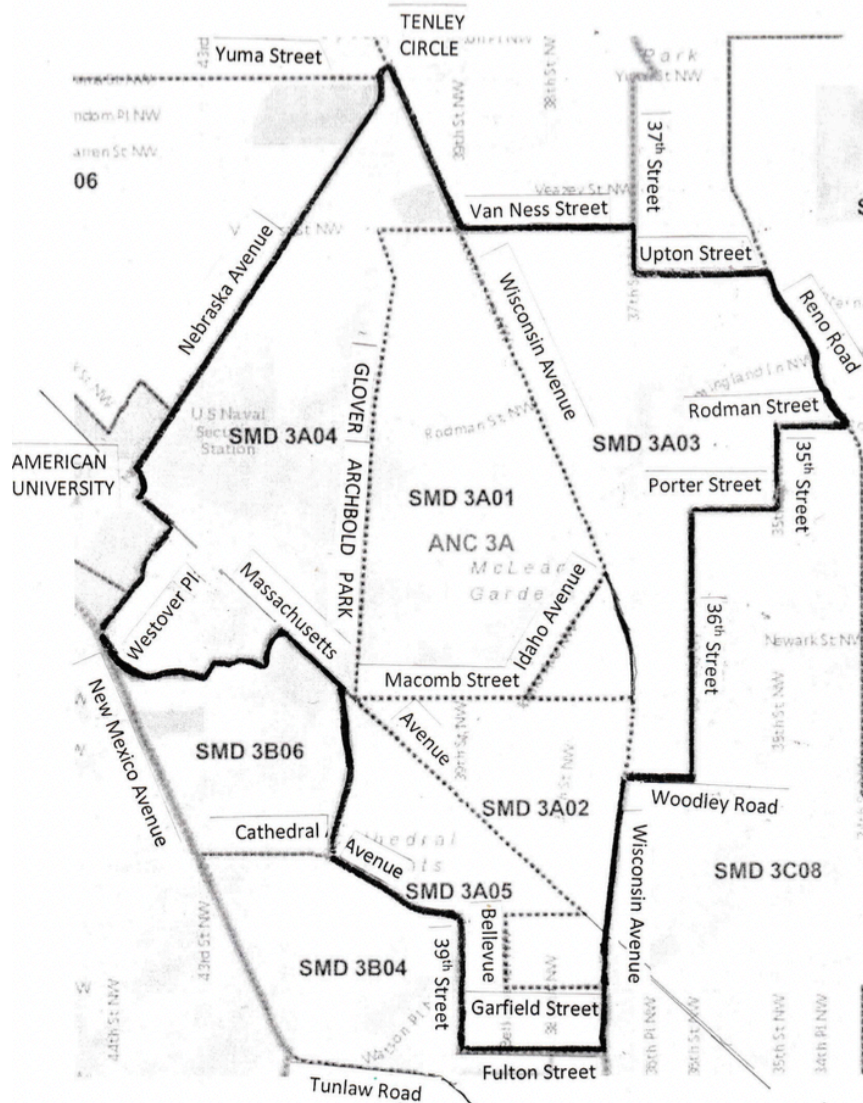
