- 6200 Dix Street NE crowds throughout the day
- Ask MPD to patrol the area for a block presence
- 6 present/1 by phone of 9 commissioners
- DDOT finally cleaned up the block – done a great job
- Still has concerns about Nannie Helen Burroughs/Division Avenue = trees/brush need cutting – beautification needs to take place
- 600 block of 49th – more speed bumps the resident is without a car. 4th car totaled (major problem) painting and paving as well
