

Minutes of the September 17, 2025 meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1D

Meeting Call to Order

At 7:00 pm, Angela Allison, Chair, called the meeting to order. [] of seven ANC1D commissioners joined the meeting at the outset of the meeting, representing a quorum. Agenda Approval

- Commissioner Nunez requested that we remove the grant presentation as the applicant as requested that we delay into November and December.
- Commissioner Wyers motioned to approve the agenda, including the consent agenda, with the clarifications above and it was seconded by Commissioner Allison. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and the consent agenda was approved with a 7-0-0 vote.

DC Government Presentations:

- Phil Thomas from the Mayor’s Office of Community Affairs offered commentary from the Mayor’s Office and answer community and Commissioner questions.
- Captain Hawkins from 4D provided a public safety update from MPD Fourth District.
- Captain Jones was not available to provide a public safety update from MPD Third District.

New Business:

- Resolution on Federal Law Enforcement Identification Standards
 - Commission Decker moved to approve the resolution and Commissioner Parbhoo seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and the resolution was approved with a 7-0-0 vote.

- Resolution Condemning Extended Federal Law Enforcement Coordination
 - Commissioner Allison moved to approve the resolution and Commissioner Núñez seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and the resolution was approved with a 7-0-0 vote.
- DC Water Shutoff in Multi-unit Buildings
 - Commissioner Patrick introduced this issue, a recent DC water policy change that has led to water shutoffs in multi-unit buildings.
- Resolution Requesting a Streetery Design Permit Waiver Process for Mount Pleasant Street Businesses
 - Commissioner Núñez introduced an amended version of the resolution for consideration.
 - Commissioner Decker moved to approve the resolution as amended and Commissioner Wyers seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and the resolution was approved with a 7-0-0 vote.

Old Business:

- Commissioner Wyers provided an update on Amigos Park. The Department of General Services is moving forward with the construction of Amigos Park on DC land. They will schedule a community meeting.

Grants Business:

- As noted at the top of the meeting, the grant applicant originally scheduled to present during this meeting requested to postpone to a later meeting.

Committee Reports:

- Commissioner Parbhoo gave an update on the Committee of the Whole.

Treasurer's Report:

- Commissioner Wyers provided an update on the budget and the monthly spending.
- ANC 1D Quarterly Financial Report FY25Q1: There was a \$50 mistake on a check on this quarterly report. We need to approve this revision.
 - Commissioner Falk motion to approve this revision and Decker seconded the motion. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and this revision was approved 7-0-0.
- ANC1D Quarterly Financial Report FY25Q2: We need to approve this report.
 - Commissioner Falk motioned to approve this report and Commissioner Allison seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and this report was approved 7-0-0.
- ANC 1D Quarterly Financial Report FY25Q3: We need to approve this report.
 - Commissioner Falk motioned to approve this report and Commissioner Núñez seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and this report was approved 7-0-0.
- Update to FY2025 budget: We need to add \$350 to the FY2025 budget to cover Spanish translation from the special June meeting.
 - Commissioner Decker motioned to approve this change to the FY25 budget and Commissioner Falk seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and this report was approved 7-0-0.
- Approving the FY2026 budget:
 - Commissioner Wyers noted some changes between the FY25 and the proposed FY26 budget. We are adding \$7200 for personnel to cover our administrative assistant and we

are increasing the grant spending from \$20,000 to \$25,000 to grants. We are also adding money for trainings.

- Commissioner Patrick noted that the budget that was shared in the meeting was showing \$6,000 for personnel but it should show \$7,200.
- Commissioner Falk motioned to approve the budget with updated figure of \$7200 for personnel. Commissioner Decker seconded. Vice Chair Parbhoo called a voice vote and the FY26 budget was approved 7-0-0.

Secretary's Report:

- Commissioner Patrick introduced our new administrative assistant and encouraged folks to sign up for the ANC newsletter.

Commissioner Updates:

- Commissioner Decker gave an update on the Parkwood Place Block Party.
- Commissioner Núñez gave information about Friday's Community Join Fair and Sunday's Mount Pleasant Transit Party.
- Commissioner Patrick gave an update on the 17th street sidewalk construction by the National Park Service.
