 - Respond to 311 complaints daily, rats most active during spring/summer
 - Pandemic led to more trash, more rat activity
 - Be sure to use garbage disposal or composting, keep food waste from being in the alley for long periods of time
 - Rodenticide goes directly into rat burrows, the hole is covered, so does not hurt other animals or children
 - Reach out to MOCRS/Commissioners for support as needed
 - Call 311 for dead rat collection, typically come the same day
