KEY ISSUES VOTED ON

2025

March ANC 5E passed <u>a resolution</u> in response to the DDOT Notice of Intent (NOI) on changes to accommodate the WMATA Better Bus network changes on 3rd St NW.

July + ANC 5E voted to <u>support eminent domain</u> and opposed the map amendment from Octob MU4 to MU 7B for the current developer of 1600 North Capitol St NW in July. In

er October, ANC 5E also voted against the map amendment request for the current owner of 1600 N. Capitol St NW and in support of eminent domain of the property (letter, form).

COMMENTS SUBMITTED TO D.C. AGENCIES

2024 DDOT

The commission voted on two resolutions for DDOT, one in response to NOI-24-301-TESD, and another in response to ANC 5F's resolution ANC5F-25-113 on asking DDOT to propose designs for protected bike lanes along Q and R Streets NW

2025

Jan Rock 'N' Roll Marathon

The commission voted to issue a <u>letter</u> to the D.C. Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency in support of the 2025 Rock 'N' Roll Marathon and its associated street closings.

Mi Casa

The commission voted to issue a <u>letter</u> to D.C. Department of Housing and Community Development in support of the Mi Casa development at Florida Avenue NW and Q St NW.

Board of Zoning Adjustment (BZA)

ANC 5E voted to support application 20949A for 57 W St NW.

Feb. Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA)

ANC 5E voted to approve a settlement agreement for Lucid X Dreams (case: ABRA-127841).

Mar District Department of Transportation

ANC 5E voted to <u>support a resolution</u> asking the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) to prioritize pedestrian safety and advocated for changes to pedestrian light timings at key intersections in 5E.

ANC 5E also passed <u>a resolution</u> in response to the DDOT Notice of Intent (NOI) on changes to accommodate the WMATA Better Bus network changes.

Zoning Commission

ANC 5E voted to support 13-14E regarding the modification of significance for the Reservoir District development by Jair Lynch.

BZA

ANC 5E voted to support BZA 21274 for 21 Channing St to both increase the footprint of an existing non-conforming accessory building and to construct an accessory apartment in a new second floor of the accessory building that is not attached to the existing R3 principal dwelling unit. ANC 5E also voted to support BZA 21272 for 54 Randolph PI NW for the construction of a detached, one-story accessory garage, to an existing, attached two-story with basement, principle dwelling unit in RF-1 zone.

Apr ABCA

ANC 5E voted to support the liquor license renewals for Big Bear Cafe (case: ABRA-084379) and Red Hen (case: ABRA-090832). The commission voted to protest the application by Alotmo, LLC (case: ABRA-131508).

May **BZA**

ANC 5E voted to support BZA 21313 for 30 W St NW for a proposed third floor addition to an existing building.

Jun Medstar National Rehabilitation Hospital - renovations

At its public meeting, ANC5E voted to support afterhours work on the federal and local holiday of Juneteenth (June 19) for renovations at Medstar National Rehabilitation Hospital.

Jul Executive Office of the Mayor (EOM)

ANC 5E voted to <u>support eminent domain</u> of 1600 North Capitol St NW and to oppose the map amendment from MU4 to MU 7B for the current developer

DDOT

ANC 5E passed a <u>resolution</u> in support of DDOT's NOI 25-154-CPD for safety improvements on North Capitol St. The commission also passed a <u>resolution</u> on concerns regarding new signals and signage installed on the 2600-2800 Blocks of North Capitol St. NE without an NOI or public comment.

Sept. ABCA

ANC 5E voted to support the renewal of Bacio Pizzeria's license (case: ABRA-130647).

EOM

In a special call meeting, ANC 5E passed a <u>resolution</u> condemning federal overreach in DC policing and demanding the immediate return of local funds. ANC 5E also passed a <u>resolution</u> advocating for federal agents and officers to identify themselves while operating in the District.

DDOT

ANC 5E passed a <u>resolution</u> advocating for better bus shelters as part of the new bus

shelter franchise agreement in the works by DDOT. The commission also voted to support the public space application changes for Mi Casa, and oppose the public space application request for 1600 N. Capitol St NW.

Oct ABCA

ANC 5E voted to support the liquor license renewals for Showtime and 7Drum City. ANC 5E also voted against the map amendment request for the current owner of 1600 N. Capitol St NW and in support of eminent domain of the property (letter, form).

At a special call meeting, ANC 5E also passed a resolution calling on DPR to open the Dunbar Aquatic pool, and submitted comments on ZC 25-12 with <u>a form</u> and <u>letter</u>.

Nov ABCA

ANC 5E voted to support the renewal of Gold Clover Bar's license (ABRA-127456). ANC 5E also voted to conditionally support the renewal of Tyber Creek's license (ABRA 105738) subject to the owner changing their trade name to their operating name (etabli).

DDOT

ANC 5E voted to send a <u>letter to DDOT</u> regarding lack of response to ANC 5E's resolutions.

OANC

ANC 5E voted to approve the Annual Report.
