ANC 6E Official Actions

November 20, 2025

- Passed a resolution in support of a two-year time extension of approved second-stage Planned Unit Development (PUD) for the center block of Capitol Crossing (Z.C. Case Nos. 08-34L and 08-34M).
- Passed a resolution that encourages the transfer of the ownership of the site located at the intersection of Hook and Ladder Alley and Massachusetts Avenue NW from the D.C. Special Meeting on September 2, 2025

- Passed a resolution that:
 - Urges Congress to reject any joint resolution extending the federal control of MPD beyond 30 days and to pass legislation, including the D.C. National Guard Home Rule Act, to eliminate federal control over local police and to strengthen D.C. self-governance
 - Implores Congress to immediately restore the \$1 billion in locally raised funds to the District's budget so that local leadership can ensure that investments prioritize community needs, including education, workforce development, health care, and other critical services that allow families and neighborhoods to thrive
- Passed a resolution that urges the DC authorities to work with federal law enforcement agents to establish protocols on masking and identification of law enforcement.

July 31, 2025
