Virtual Meeting Procedures:

3. All attendees will be muted by the meeting host. When recognized to speak, the meeting host will unmute the attendee.
4. After a presenter completes his or her presentation, attendees will be given an opportunity to ask their questions or make comments followed by Commissioners.
5. During meetings, residents should use the raise hand to request to comment, and they

will then be recognized by the chair. Attendees may also use the chat function to make comments.

6. Attendees will have an opportunity to be heard once on an issue before anyone is heard twice.
7. If many attendees want to speak on an issue, priority will be given to ANC3E residents first and then if time allows residents who live outside of ANC3E will be recognized.
