

Duncan.</i></p> <p>Chair Horn introduced Mr. Nick Keenan who conducted the election of ANC 3D officers for 2026.</p> <p><u>Chair</u></p> <p>Commissioner Duncan nominated Commissioner Bernie Horn; Commissioner Szymkowicz seconded the nomination. No other nominations or discussion took place. Commissioner Horn was unanimously elected as ANC3D Chair for 2026 with a vote of 6-0-0.</p> <p><u>Vice Chair</u></p> <p>Commissioner Szymkowicz nominated Commissioner Tricia Duncan; Commissioner Horn seconded the nomination. No other nominations or discussion took place. Commissioner Duncan was unanimously elected as ANC3D Vice Chair for 2026 with a vote of 6-0-0.</p>

Commissioner Elkins was unanimously elected as ANC3D Treasurer for 2026 with a vote of 6-0-0.</p> <p><u>Secretary</u></p> <p>Commissioner Duncan nominated Commissioner Marilyn Nowalk; Commissioner Szymkowicz seconded the nomination. No other nominations or discussion took place.
