Office of Mayor Muriel Bowser-Amber Wright, ward 7 moca (updates)

Mayor Bowser swore in Jeffery W. Carroll as interim Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department. On January 8th the district closed its 100th illegal cannabis business since enforcement began in September 2024. The 2nd phase of the leaf collection in Section A in Wards 1-8 is underway. On Thursday January 15 @ 4pm the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services will be having a Resource Fair for all DC residents. On Monday January 19 @ 10:30am walk with the Bowser Administration in the MLK Day Holiday Parade. The Department of Parks and Recreation has extended free skating and skate rentals at the Fort Dupont ice arena through Saturday, January 17.

Office of Councilmember Wendell Felder,- Letisha Vinson (updates)

Every Wednesday the Constituent Services team is in the ward, they will be at the DGS building at 3924 Minnesota Ave., if you would like to come and talk, no appointment required. There’s a survey for the budget; the survey is due by February 15 and the letters from ANC, Civics and organizations is due February 17. There will be a RFK redevelopment meeting on January 28th from 5-9 at Benning Stoddard.

6. New Business

BZA Case No. 21410 (2318, 2322, 2324, Nicholson St SE) Zachery Williams Attorney with Venable. They will be replacing single -family homes and other structures with new apartment buildings. The proposed project site plan, 18,000 s.f. consolidated lot area, 48.6 feet high (5 stories), 62 affordable units, 11 parking spaces (19 required), 28 bicycle parking spaces (24 required) and 1 partial loading space. The only relief they’re looking for is partial loading space.
