a. Treasurer's Report.

Comr. Beltran reported that the current ledger ending balance is \$ 70,561.45

Comr. Beltran presented the FY25 Q3 Quarterly Financial Report and moved to approve the report. The report was APPROVED unanimously. *(Motion by Comr. Juanita Beltran)*

5. COMMUNITY CONCERNS

Youth & Community Safety Discussions: Residents were informed that the Council of the District of Columbia considered and delayed action on legislation to extend the youth curfew, following community concerns regarding youth and young people across the city. Community members were encouraged to remain engaged and provide input on youth and public safety discussions moving forward.

Public Safety & Federal Oversight Tensions: Residents were also informed that the Council of the District of Columbia took action on matters related to public safety and federal oversight, as August 2025 marked a significant period for public safety discussions in the District. The community was encouraged to stay informed and engaged on issues impacting local safety and governance.

6. OTHER BUSINESS / COMMISSIONER CONCERNS / COMMUNITY CALENDAR / ANNOUNCEMENTS

Constituents were informed that the Council of the District of Columbia is considering and voting on several matters that may impact the community, and that public input is strongly encouraged regarding the proposed RFK Stadium Redevelopment Deal.

Constituents were further informed of legislative actions related to Housing Authority reform, aimed at addressing longstanding operational challenges within the District's housing system, and were encouraged to provide input on these matters.

Residents were also informed of ongoing Council actions pertaining to youth and public safety, including community safety discussions, and were advised that community engagement and input remain important in shaping these initiatives.

The Commission adjourned at approximately 8:55 pm.
