GUEST SPEAKERS/PRESENTERS

Captain Pullium of the Metropolitan Police Department presented a report on public safety. A representative from the Agriculture Initiative Program provided a brief presentation on urban agriculture efforts, including identifying available spaces within the community for growing vegetables. Michael Murphy also delivered a report related to the Metropolitan Police Department. Additionally, a

representative from MOCRS provided updates on current initiatives being advanced by the Mayor's Office.

1. APPROVE MINUTES AND AGENDA

2. REPORTS

a. Treasurer's Report.

Comr. Beltran reported that the current ledger ending balance is \$ 57,306.38

Comr. Beltran presented the FY25 Q4 financial report and moved for its approval. The Commission APPROVED (5–1) the FY25 Q4 report upon a duly made motion *(Motion by Comr. Juanita Beltran)*. The Commission further authorized the Treasurer to make any necessary minor clerical or typographical corrections to the report, provided such changes do not alter the substance of the financial statements.

3. OLD BUSINESS

No old business was presented by commission.

4. NEW BUSINESS

- a. The Commission APPROVED (5–1) the allocation of \$1,000 to Fihankra Akoma Ntoaso (FANDC), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization serving youth in the community through after-school programming, upon a duly made motion *(Motion by Comr. Juanita Beltran)*

5. COMMUNITY CONCERNS

Residents expressed concerns regarding ongoing development projects, parking availability, and public safety, including individuals congregating in front of buildings, suspected drug activity, and smoking. Additional concerns were raised regarding the Department of Public Works (DPW) and the adequacy of street cleaning and maintenance services within the community.

6. OTHER BUSINESS / COMMISSIONER CONCERNS / COMMUNITY CALENDAR / ANNOUNCEMENTS

Residents were informed that the Council of the District of Columbia is continuing to work on and advance final legislation related to the RFK redevelopment project, the Rental Act of 2025, public safety initiatives, and Housing Authority reforms, all of which may have a direct impact on the community.

The Commission adjourned at approximately 9:50 pm.
