FINAL MEETING MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 2026 GENERAL BODY MEETING

1) Call to Order and Roll Call:

- a. The February 2026 ANC 1E general body meeting was held on February 25, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom. Meeting called to order by Chair Jacobson at 7:03 pm. Commissioner Howard took the roll call:

- b. With five-of-seven seated Commissioners in attendance, a quorum was present.
c. Chair Jacobson stated that the community received notice via listserv, social media, website, and e-calendar.
d. Commissioner Howard moved to adopt the agenda and it was properly seconded. The motion was adopted 5-0-0.

5) Official Business

a. **#1E-2026-0202: Resolution Establishing a Special Committee on Georgia Avenue Economic Development**

- i) Chairperson Jacobson presented the resolution establishing a Special Committee on Georgia Avenue Economic Development.
- ii) Commissioner Grant made a motion to adopt the resolution establishing a Special Committee on Georgia Avenue Economic Development. With no dissents, the motion was adopted.
- iii) Following adoption of the resolution, the Commission proceeded to the chair election for the newly established committee. Commissioner Footer nominated Commissioner Audra Grant and Commissioner Josh Jacobson to serve as co-chairs. There being no further nominations, ANC 1E elected Commissioner Grant and Commissioner Jacobson as co-chairs by acclamation.

b) **#1E-2026-0203: Resolution on Snow Emergency Service Equity, Public Communication, and Pedestrian Access**

- i) Chairperson Jacobson presented the resolution on snow emergency service equity, public communication, and pedestrian access.
- ii) Commissioner Howard moved to amend the resolution by adding the Commission's February 2025 storm survey results as Appendix A and directing that Appendix A be attached to the approved minutes for this meeting as part of the Commission's official record. Commissioner Footer seconded. The amendment was adopted 5-0-0.
- iii) Chairperson Jacobson offered an additional amendment requesting that a relevant District agency conduct a study on the economic impact and losses associated with snowstorms like the January storm. With no dissents, the amendment was adopted.

- iv) Commissioner Howard moved the previous question. Commissioner Footer seconded. The motion was adopted 5-0-0.

 - c) **#1E-2026-0204: Resolution in Support of the District's Recognition of Caribbean American Heritage Month and Encouraging Caribbean Heritage Month Activation Along Lower Georgia Avenue NW**
 - i) Commissioner Howard presented the resolution. Commissioner Brown asked to be added as a collaborator.
 - ii) Commissioner Howard made a motion to adopt the resolution. Commissioner Footer seconded. The motion was adopted 5-0-0.
 - d) **#1E-2026-0205: Urging Expanded Voter Education and Neighborhood Outreach on Ranked-Choice Voting Ahead of the June 2026 Primary**
 - i) Commissioner Howard presented the resolution urging expanded voter education and neighborhood outreach on ranked choice voting ahead of the June 2026 primary. Discussion followed regarding outreach by the Board of Elections and how ANC 1E could support voter education.
