MEETING MINUTES

The regular public meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1E was held virtually on Wednesday, March 25, 2026. Chair Josh Jacobson called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. ET. Secretary Brad Howard called the roll.

A quorum was not present, with three of seven current Commissioners present at the time of the roll call.

Notice of the meeting was provided through community listservs, social media, the ANC 1E website, and eCalendar.

Because a quorum was not present, no official action was taken. The meeting proceeded with presentations, announcements, and other non-action items.

Presentations and community updates were provided by Eliza Roche-Robinson of the Office of Ward 1 Councilmember Brianne Nadeau, Enrique Lopez of the Mayor's Office of Community Relations and Services, and Sean Moore of DC Water regarding the Lead Free DC program.

No community announcements were made.

Informal officer and committee updates were provided regarding the Transportation and Public Space Committee, the Zoning and Economic Development Committee, settlement-agreement matters related to Hook Hall, the Public Safety and Engagement Committee, and recruitment for the Georgia Avenue Economic Development Special Committee.

Commissioner Philip Newland (1E05) joined during discussion of Resolution #1E-2026-0302 and before official action was taken. A quorum was then present, with four of seven current Commissioners present.

The Chair returned to the orders of the day. On motion of Commissioner Brad Howard, the agenda was adopted, 4-0-0.

On motion of Commissioner Philippa Hawker, the consent agenda was adopted by unanimous consent, consisting of the following items:

On motion of Commissioner Brad Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-0302, Requesting Documentation and Oversight Regarding Condominium Warranty Security Compliance at 3619 Georgia Avenue NW, was adopted, 4-0-0.
