Commissioners asked about parking, MPD coordination, cleanup after parade/coordination with DPW.

Second District, Metropolitan Police Department (MPD)

Lt. A Sakulich of the Second District reported 24 crimes for ANC2F, 7 of which were in 2D – all property crimes. No violent crimes reported this past month. Announced new Commander for 2D – Commander Christopher Dorsey. Commander Dorsey briefly introduced himself.

Third District, Metropolitan Police Department (MPD)

No representation attended from the Third District.

Hannah Ames – Constituent Services Coordinator, Ward 2 DC Council

The Office of Councilmember Pinto provided updates on legislative meetings including the curfew, public safety, and the upcoming elections with primaries taking place in June 2026.

Commissioners pointed out no representation from the Third District attended the meeting and asked Hanna Ames to share with the Office of Councilmember Pinto and her team.

Community Questions and Discussion

Community members and Commissioners discussed ongoing safety concerns around 14th and P St. NW. Community members have placed 311 reports but no resolution has occurred. He shared 311 closes the ticket, but no repairs or changes occur. This has been occurring for at least the past six months.
