ANC 5E Public Meeting Minutes (March 2026)

Tuesday, March 17, 2026

Present: Commissioners Kyle Gardiner, Karla Lewis, Andrew Waks, Huma Imtiaz, Alice Thompson, and Kirby Vining.

1. Commissioner Imtiaz provided instructions for public participation in the meeting.
2. The meeting was held virtually via Zoom and began at 7 p.m. ET with a quorum with five Commissioners present.
3. Commissioner Vining moved to approve the consent calendar with the March 2026 meeting agenda and the February 17, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion.

In addition, ANC 5E received two recent quarterly allocations from the ANC: the Q3 FY26 full allotment and restoration of \$413.74 from the Q2 FY26 allotment. Commissioner Vining further noted that check #512 for \$150 to the ANC's virtual assistant, written and mailed in Sept. 25, still has not been cashed. He has asked the OANC about this and was told that the check is probably stale as it was written more than 90 days ago and had not been cashed. He has emailed our virtual assistant to ask if the check had been received and what was done with it but has not received a response. Following this meeting, he will ask the OANC to deduct that payment as uncashed.
